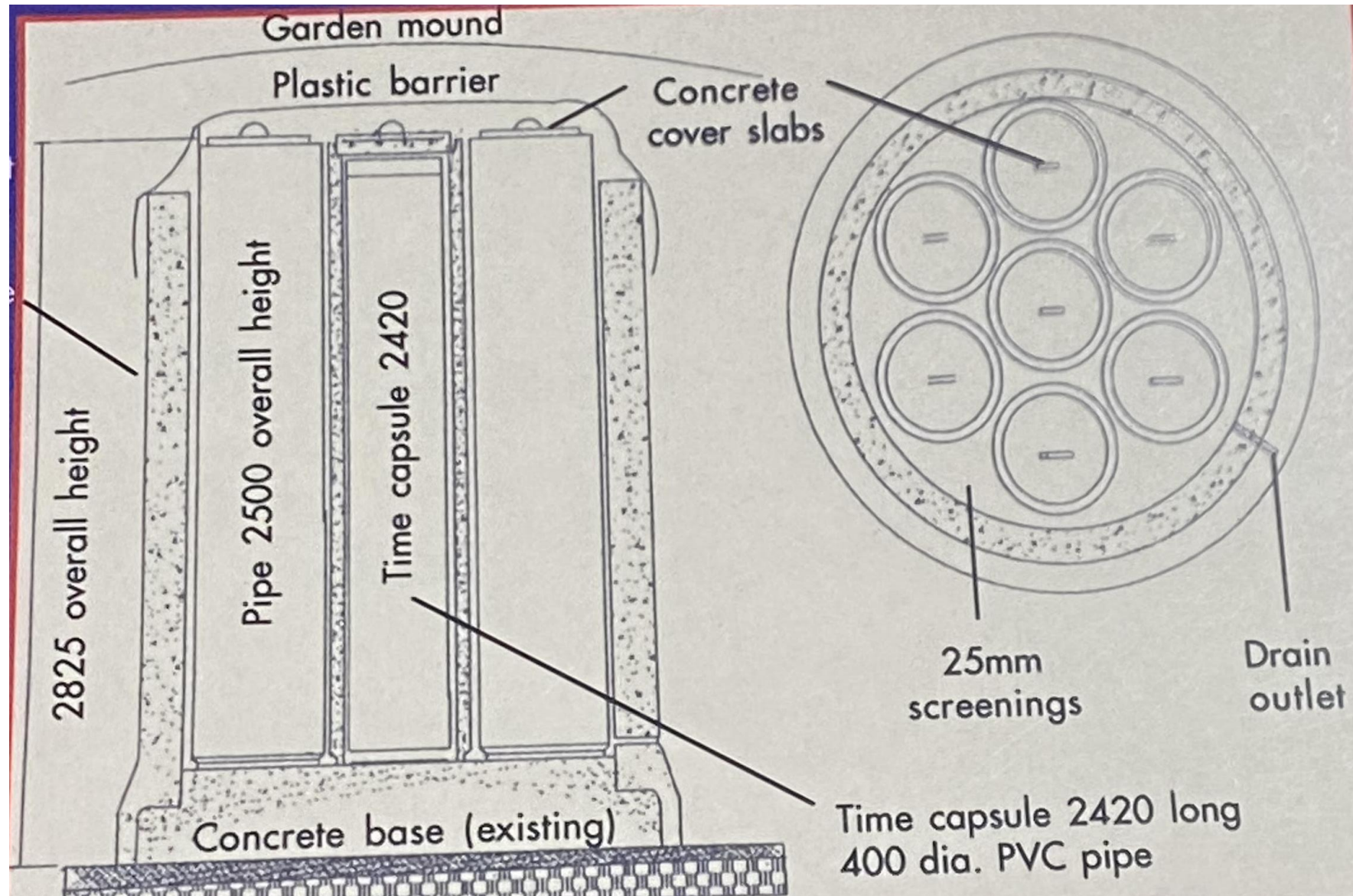
Summary

- On Australia Day 2000, the Hobson's Bay Millennium Time Capsule was launched with messages from more than 12,000 Hobsons Bay families, schools, community groups and businesses.
- It is buried at the City's highest point (Mt Truganina, the former Altona Tip site), is a "brainchild" of former Councillor, G. Burnnard, and is due for opening Australia Day 2025.
- HB Mayor, Cr Dick Murdoch, lowered the capsules into a concrete vault, with the event watched by ~400 people.
- Following vandalism, the Hobsons Bay Council arranged a protective cover and signage.
